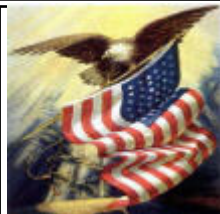

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

I hope that you all had a wonderful holiday season and enjoyed your family and friends. The New Year should be a time to renew relationships and extend friendship to someone you don't know - perhaps someone who hasn't been seen for a while or someone who shares your interests? Think about reaching out to some of our club members who are not able to attend events or perhaps their interest in old cars just needs a "jump start".

I was watching the CBS Sunday Morning show this past Sunday and one of the segments dealt with what it like 100 years ago in 1911. The show raised an interesting factoid. In May of 1911 was the first Indianapolis 500. The car that won the first event was a Marmon Wasp driven by Ray Harroun. He finished in first place after 6 hours, 42 minutes and 8 seconds. His average speed was just over 76 mph. He was an engineer first and a racer second. He designed the six-cylinder from stock Marmon engine components. Mr. Haroun came up with another innovation that is now standard equipment—a rear view mirror. He was the first driver to race without a riding mechanic to watch for cars from behind. The Indy 500 is one of the most cherished automotive events. Among a slew of commemorative events in the pipeline for that landmark anniversary is the creation of a U.S. Postal Service stamp honoring the first 500 in 1911, unveiled this week and set to go on sale in May 2011.

It's a USPS "forever" stamp, with its imagery of Ray Harroun's winning Marmon Wasp of 1911 created in Art Deco fashion by John Mattos. The 2011 issue will mark the second time that the Wasp has appeared on a U.S. stamp, the first being as a 17.5-cent postal commemorative that was part of a series on transportation. To provide some context, that was in 1987.
