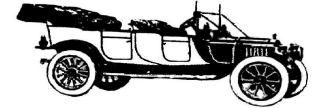

The resolution also directs the Eastern Idaho Chapter Secretary to file standard form dissolution documents with the Secretary of the State of Idaho and to provide notification of such dissolution to the national office of the VMCCA.

After the satisfaction of all debts, the distribution of assets occurs. Any assets that are not liquid (all equipments, merchandise and other chapter owned property) is to be sold and converted to cash. A listing of all chapter owned property, merchandise, equipment, cash, bank accounts and balances as well as the current listing of scholarships shall be maintained by the Eastern Idaho Chapter Secretary. Liquidated assets (cash) will be distributed evenly to the scholarships funded by the Eastern Idaho Chapter of the VMCCA.

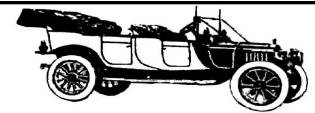

Comments included from May and June Meetings. Revised June 2011 for inclusion in the July newsletter and to be voted on at the July 14, 2011 meeting as prescribed by the by-laws. Changes are the addition of Article X Dissolution (below) and renumbering the existing Article X to Article XI. The words "Revised By-Laws shall be transmitted to the VMCCA Bonneville region office." Were added to Article XI. The By-Laws are labeled as revised effective July 14, 2011.

Article X Dissolution

The dissolution process commences with a resolution developed by the officers and the board of directors. The resolution shall be presented to the Director of the Bonneville Region to verify that the dissolution process cannot be resolved. Following the determination by the Regional Director, the resolution shall be voted on by the Eastern Idaho Chapter members. Once approved by the membership, the officers are required to settle all debts, distribute assets and terminate operations of the Eastern Idaho Chapter of the VMCCA. The resolution also directs the Eastern Idaho Chapter Secretary to file standard form dissolution documents with the Secretary of the State of Idaho and to provide notification of such dissolution to the Bonneville Regional office of the VMCCA.

After the satisfaction of all debts, the distribution of assets occurs. Any assets that are not liquid (all equipment, merchandise and other chapter owned property) is to be sold and converted to cash.
