Car of the Month

This month's car is Ike Ikard's 1932 Ford DeLuxe Phaeton. I did a little research on the term "phaeton" – it originally meant a light, two-seat car with minimal coachwork – similar to a racing car, but really built for touring. By the late 1910s, however, a phaeton came to be known as a car with room for three rows of seats, regardless of how many rows were actually installed.

This car is an outstanding example of the major change in styling for Ford from 1931 (the last year of the Model A) to the 1932 Model B (4 cylinder engine) and Model 18 (the flathead V-8 engine). Ike drove this car to the Apple Squeezin' this year and it was a big attraction. Thanks to Brian Edgerton for the photos.
