Meeting Minutes - September 7, 2017

President Bob Shillket conducted the meeting and Mark Schwartzberger took the minutes.

With Joy Eagle not being available at this meeting the minutes from the previous month's meeting and a treasurer's report were not available.

Yale Harker and Brian Edgerton gave an overview of the Cody tour. The tour went very well and there were good, dedicated people who helped with running this tour. Many accolades were received from National especially concerning the lunches that were handled by a local bakery in Cody. Most everything went well and tour members liked how things were done. Brian indicated that financially, after dealing with National, vendors and all payments there is approximately \$5,000 coming to the local chapter. Deb Edgerton indicated that she had received several compliments from tour members every step of the way while on the tour. Judyth Derbidge indicated that this Heritage tour did represent three separate U.S. presidents. All the coffee stops were well placed and planned well.

Brian also indicated that our local chapter is probably the best organization in the Bonneville region and that we need to really help out the Utah chapters with the planned Glidden tour in September 2018.

Judyth Derbidge presented current information regarding the Glidden tour that will be based out of Twin Falls (Sun Valley had been considered however due to costs involving hotels, meals, etc. the Twin Falls location has been finalized). She will be taking a brief tour of some of the routes on Monday (Three Island, a local winery (where a lunch will be scheduled on the Glidden tour). One tour will offer a visit to Sun Valley or to Craters of the Moon and another to City of Rocks. Tour cost is expected to be \$300 and good room rates in the available hotels in Twin Falls.

The tour name will be along the lines of "Magic in Magic Valley". The tour will be with cars 1942 and older. The Utah chapters will be hosting this tour and our chapter needs to provide our assistance to help ensure the tour is set up and run efficiently. Security at the tour hotels needs to be a priority. Our chapter should meet with the hosting chapters to discuss what has already been done and what still needs to be done. There will be a Regional Meeting on October 14th in Brigham City, Utah and it has been suggested that as many of our local members participate in this meeting so that all aspects of the tour can be discussed and what all the regional chapters can offer to make this tour successful. Bob Shilkett indicated he will let Jeff Pack know about the Regional Meeting and to put this notice in the Gas Line and encourage our local members to try to attend this meeting.

Brian Edgerton mentioned that part of the ongoing Progressive Tour will occur in Idaho in 2021 from Basalt to Lewiston and that Bob and Holly Crawley will be helping to get this organized and will be looking for much needed assistance from our local chapter members.

On Saturday September 9th there will be a memorial for Mary Littleton at Freeman Park at the Viet Nam Memorial. Members are asked to attend, if interested, and to bring their cars. Please meet at the memorial at 9:00 a.m.


Victoria Goodman also recently passed away.


Meeting Minutes - September 7, 2017 (Continued)
